
Skin tear protocol ISTAP classification for skin tears¹





Skin at risk

Mature skin is more vulnerable and prone to skin tears.

No skin loss

Linear or flap tear that can be repositioned to cover wound bed.

Partial flap loss

Partial flap loss that cannot be repositioned to cover the wound bed.

Total flap loss

Total flap loss exposing entire wound bed.¹

Application Guide



Gently cleanse the wound as per local wound care guidelines.



Approximate wound edges, classify tear, measure and document.



Mepilex® Border Lite to be applied to Type 1 and Type 2 skin tears.

Mepilex® Border Comfort to be applied to Type 3 skin tears.

If the skin tear is on the lower limb, please refer to the Lower Limb - recommendations for care pathway



Time to change

Up to 7 day wear time. However, a dressing change should be considered once the exudate spreads past the zone highlighted in red. *Change indicator dots only available on Mepil®Border Comfort

If you observe changes in the wound or surrounding skin such as increased redness, swelling, odour, pain or heat, please assess the wound and refer to local protocol.
