#### Key escalation and discussion points from the meeting

#### Alert:

• The committee did not identify any items to escalate

#### Advise:

- The bi-annual safeguarding report highlighted a low uptake of mandatory adult safeguarding training (66.7%). A plan is in place to address the issue. We will keep a watching eye on progress to improve uptake.
- An issue has been identified around the payment of Involvement Partners which could potentially discourage involvement and engagement. We agreed a speedy response will be taken to ensure that we mitigate the risk of disengagement of valued partners.

#### Assure:

- As part of the effectiveness review of the Q&SC the care groups will have a different way of reporting into committee. A review of Q&SC is ongoing.
- Q&SC received 9 comprehensive and high quality bi-annual, quarterly and annual reports which provided a high level of assurance about our organisations commitment to provide high quality safe services. Staff were congratulated.

#### Risks discussed:

• The need to avoid grade 4 pressure ulcers was highlighted, steps to mitigate noted and focus to be maintained.
